The Panel has served as a forum for both the scientific community and public, and has affected both the initiation of new program priorities and implementation of existing priorities. The AD serves as the Executive Secretary to the Panel. In addition to meetings held in the Washington/Bethesda area, during 1982 the President's Cancer Panel conducted public meetings on the east coast at the Harvard University School of Public Health, and on the west coast at the University of California in Los Angeles. At these meetings the Panel examined alternatives and options proposed by scientists regarding possible modifications of the peer review and grants award mechanisms at the NCI and the NIH. The AD is also Director of the Office of Medical Applications of Cancer Research (OMACR) and maintains liaison with the NIH Office of Medical Applications of Research (OMAR). During 1982...
